Do You Know What is In Your Pet's Food?

Did you know that most commercial bought dog food can legally contain by-products. By-products are unused parts of animals, dead and diseased animals, even animals that were euthanized, fecal matter, cows, chickens, pigs that cannot be used for human consumption. These items are taken to rendering plants who process the matter add grain and preservatives and package it as dog or cat food. The medicine that is given animals to euthanize them does not magically go away during the rendering process. Therefore, you can be slowly killing your animal if this is in the food you feed them. I have read that even the animals collars get ground up during rendering and can be in the food. I think this is just horrible and most people do not even realize that their food can contain such things.

Late last night I realized that I was out of cat food so I ran to the grocery store near my house. I could not find one can of cat food that did not contain by-products. Needless to say, my cat got a can of "human" tuna that night!

I feed my animals primarily a holistic diet. I read the labels of all food fed to them. If the label contains any type of by-product or starts with the word grain I know not to buy that food. Or if you can not pronounce the ingredients on the label you should pass on that food as well. You should look for food that contains meat, vegetables, fruit, vitamins and very little grain. You should also give a variety of different foods instead of feeding one type of food for the life of the pet says **Hope Williams**, owner of **Best Friend Nutrition**. Hope is a former Vacaville resident that moved to Washington State to open a holistic pet food store. She is a wonderful source of information regarding pet nutrition and health. Her suggestions for holistic health are to provide plenty of pure water, a fresh nutritious diet, an indoor life free from stress, limited drugs and vaccines, behavioral training, routine exercise, grooming, dental care and consistent love and respect of your animal. She gives great nutrition consultations for around \$90. If you are having a health or behavioral problem with your pet she may be able to help. With lots of information from you, she does extensive research on the breed and will give you a food plan that will fit in with your families lifestyle.

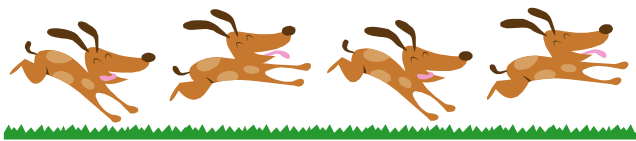

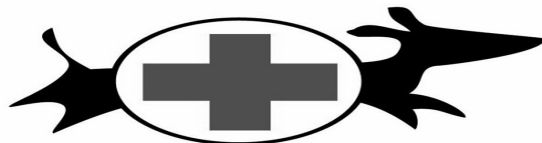
