



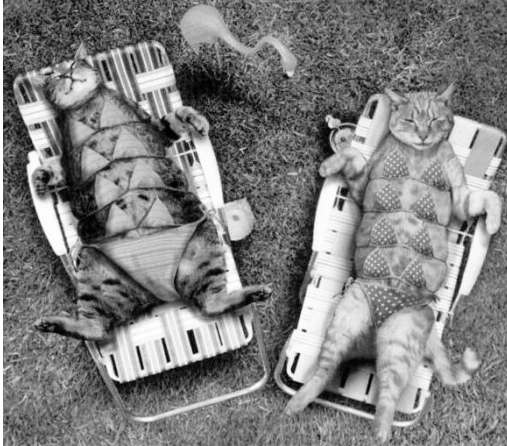

Well, we recently spoke with Vacaville Mayor, Len Augustine, who assured us that the dog park will not be affected by the redevelopment plans. So for now, it looks as if the dog park is here to stay!

## Slug and Snail Bait:

### A Threat to Your Pets

The active ingredient in most slug and snail baits, metaldehyde, is toxic to the central nervous system. Clinical signs from metaldehyde can occur within one to four hours after exposure. If your pet has had a known exposure, you should contact your veterinarian immediately. There is no antidote for metaldehyde poisoning. Treatment includes preventing absorption of the toxin if exposure is recent.

## Look Out!

The star thistle has become the most common plant in the state, and it is out of control! Sightings of this weed have been made inside the dog park. Please help us by decapitating the weed, NOT pulling it out.



Apparently, pulling the weed out only "encourages" the seeds in the soil to propagate. By chopping the head off of the growing weed, it eventually kills it.

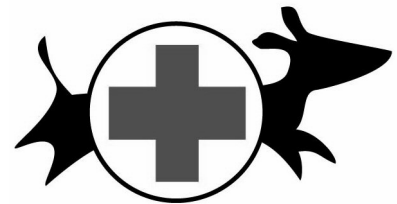
